FEA, in partnership with the Princeton Center for Leadership Training (PCLT), will present a series of regional training sessions explaining the new statute on Teen Dating Violence and its requirements, which districts must implement **immediately**.

This program will address the new requirement for districts to implement a new board policy, curriculum, and protocols for investigation, and will address the remediation of violent acts arising from dating.

Like the anti-bullying regulations, the dating violence requirements can get complicated. Consider, for instance these questions you will face:

At all our trainings, attendees have many such questions—incident-specific questions that can only be answered in person.

Q: What are the warning signs of dating violence?

Q: The school's responsibility with respect to dating violence typically does not extend to locations beyond school grounds. But that is not true of the anti-bullying law. Which rules do you follow when a dating violence issue is also a bullying issue and takes place at the mall?

Q: What is emotional abuse? Where do you draw the line?

Q: When an incident is both bullying and dating violence, who is the lead investigator – the principal or the anti-bullying specialist?

Q: What are the dating violence reporting requirements and how do they conflict with the anti-bullying requirements?

Q: What dating violence material must be included in your health curriculum?

Addressing teen dating violence requires numerous staff members. If three staff members attend, a fourth can attend **at no cost!**

- District administrators
- Building administrators
- Health and PE supervisors
- District-level anti-bullying coordinator

PCLT has also partnered with Hazelden, the publisher of Safe Dates, to become the sole licensed state-wide trainer of Safe Dates to teachers in New Jersey.
